

FUSE Media 2018 Attendee Terms & Conditions

Attendee Terms

1. As an Attendee your participation entitles you to the official FUSE Media 2018 hosted package which includes: roundtrip economy airfare or train tickets, ground transportation in Philadelphia from the airport or train station to the hotel and back, private hotel accommodations at Loews Philadelphia for the nights of October 1st and 2nd, group meals, drinks, and networking events, starting with FUSE's opening reception the evening of Monday, October 1st.
2. As an Attendee, you agree to participate in all conference program activities including keynotes and general sessions, boardroom case study sessions, and 1:1 meetings with Sponsors. You also agree to attend all scheduled meal functions and networking events. Failure to communicate issues that arise that may preclude you from fulfilling your event duties/requirements or failure to remedy such issues (such as rescheduling a 1:1 meeting) will result in your being responsible for all travel and accommodation expenses.
3. Attendees are responsible for their own travel insurance, as it is not covered by FUSE Media's organizers. Additional items that are not covered include: flight/hotel upgrades, shoulder nights (outside of October 1st and 2nd), baggage fees, personal effects and incidentals. For hotel/upgrades and shoulder nights, Attendees will be required to provide payment to the hotel upon check-in. We can assist in extending your stay at Loews Philadelphia if needed.
4. Please make sure to review and approve your flight/train itinerary as soon as possible. Once you confirm it with our travel coordinator and it is booked, any changing or altering of ticket will be at your expense.
5. If you are no longer employed or become aware that you will no longer be employed at the time of FUSE Media by the media or publishing company based upon which you were approved to attend FUSE, you must let us know immediately upon you becoming aware so that we can cancel your participation in the program. In such case, you will no longer be eligible to participate in the program nor will FUSE be responsible for your travel or hotel costs.
6. Qualification to attend FUSE Media is determined solely by FUSE Media and may be revoked at any time.

Cancellation and/or failure to comply: If you cancel your participation at FUSE Media 2018 and we have arranged for your flights or trains, you will be responsible for the cost of these tickets plus a \$250 cancellation fee. You will be invoiced for your ticket and cancellation fee upon cancellation. You will then have the full value of your ticket to use as you wish. Note: Some transportation may have a change fee or a cancellation fee.
